





Stellar Acrobatic Dance Academy and Rising Star Acrobatic Dance are both nonprofit organizations located in Cleveland, Ohio with a mission to provide an excellent cultural dance education for children. In 2015 Stellar Acrobatic Dance Academy was founded by three internationally known Chinese acrobats. They have participated in many international shows around the world.



More than eight hundred students

have already benefited from the teachings of the Three Sisters. Students have the opportunity to perform throughout the year in local community settings. By including this strong extracurricular activity, these students learn not only dance techniques but also confidence, self-discipline and an appreciation of other cultures through performance.

4:00pm - The Ohio Samul Nori and Jeon's Tae Kwon Do Academy

Samul nori is a genre of percussion music that originated in Korea. The word samul means "four objects", while nori means "play". Samul nori is performed with four traditional Korean musical instruments. They are Kkwaenggwari, a small gong; Jing, a larger gong; Janggu, an hourglass-shaped drum; and Buk, a barrel drum similar to the bass drum.

Samul nori's roots are in Pungmul nori, meaning "playing Korean traditional percussion instruments", which is a Korean folk genre comprising music, acrobatics, folk dance, and rituals. Samul nori was traditionally performed in rice-farming villages in order to ensure and to celebrate good harvests. Until modern times, nine-tenths of Korea's people were employed in agricultural work, and this genre defined Korean music. Samul nori is the formalized, more modern version of Pungmul nori.

Jeon's Tae Kwan Do Academy has been a leader in Northeast Ohio martial arts instruction for over 15 years. We take pride in the fact that our classes in Taekwondo, Hapkido, Judo, Cardio Kick-boxing, and Asian Weapons are all taught by certified Master Instructors.

About the Cleveland Cultural Gardens

The Cleveland Cultural Gardens are a proud reflection of Northeast Ohio, a reflection of its many diverse cultures, proud ethnic traditions, and welcoming spirit.

The gardens are part of Rockefeller Park, land donated to the city of Cleveland by industrialist John D. Rockefeller in 1896. The idea for an outdoor cultural oasis was launched in 1916, when Shakespeare enthusiast and publisher Leo Weidenthal developed a spot in the park to honor the bard in what is now known as the British Cultural Garden.

Weidenethal, elected officials and other community leaders observed the many immigrant groups who were arriving in Cleveland in the early 20th century, and envisioned other gardens that could pay tribute to different cultures.



The Hebrew Cultural Garden was established in 1926 by the growing Jewish community in Glenville. Other early gardens were predominantly European (Italian, Hungarian, Polish, German, Irish, for example) an expression of the immigrant groups that had been settling in Cleveland.

The early gardens were helped along by the federal government's jobs program, the Works Progress Administration, during the Great Depression. The WPA employed stone cutters and other immigrant laborers to build the intricate gardens that stretch from East Boulevard down to Martin Luther King Boulevard.

As the decades passed, immigration patterns changed and so did the gardens. From WWII to the present, gardens from the Baltic States, the Middle East, Asia and Africa have been created, along with an African American Cultural Garden.

As of mid-2023, some 35 gardens had been officially dedicated, and more were in development, including a Native American Garden, and gardens from France, Scotland, Colombia, Uzbekistan, Korea, Vietnam, Egypt, Mexico, the Philippines and Peru. The Pakistani Garden officially will be dedicated at today's One World Day, as the first phase of it construction has been completed.



The Gardens are home to more than 80 statues, honoring the likes of Gandhi, Nikolai Tesla, Marie Curie, Chopin, Mother Teresa, Jean Sibelius, Nizar Qabbani, and others. More cultural icons, symbolic monuments and landscaping can be found in or will be coming soon to the Cultural Gardens.

Each of the gardens is cared for by non-profit sponsoring organizations, typically an ethnic organization, cultural association, museum or church. Driven by love of their heritage, volunteers from these groups dedicate time, talent

and treasure tending to the flowers, weeding, and raising funds for installations, repairs and maintenance.

The non-profit Cleveland Cultural Gardens Federation is the governing body that approves the creation of new gardens, promotes and advocates for them, and is a liaison to the city and other partnering institutions. It is the proud host of One World Day each year.

The CCGF carries on the vision that Weidenthal and so many others had more than 107 years ago and one that is critical today - that cultures of the world should learn about and celebrate each other. The mission of the Cultural Gardens, peace through mutual understanding, remains.


