Holiday CircleFest coincides with Little Italy's Holiday Art Walk. Take the CircleLink shuttle directly to Little Italy and enjoy the ambiance of Cleveland's oldest neighborhood. Cafes and bakeries, shops, and restaurants will be open all afternoon. Additional paid parking options are available, and Little Italy's "main street" is just a short walk from MOCA in Uptown.



FREE Holiday CircleFest Shuttle 12:30-6:30 p.m.

Getting around Holiday CircleFest is easy with the free shuttle bus! Simply hop on where you see the red signs, ride the shuttle to your desired destination, then hop off. A full loop on the shuttle takes approximately 30 minutes. A map and a list of shuttle stops (noted in red) can be found on page 12.

NEW: Ride the CircleLink to the Little Italy Holiday Art Walk Noon-6:00 p.m.

Take the CircleLink to Little Italy and explore its shops, galleries, and restaurants during the Holiday Art Walk.

CircleLink is a free circulator service that runs throughout the neighborhood. To get to Little Italy, hop on a CircleLink bus at the Cleveland Museum of Natural History, Cleveland Museum of Art, on Ford Road, or at the Little Italy-University Circle Red Line Rapid Station. A full loop on the CircleLink takes approximately 30 minutes. A map and relevant CircleLink stops (noted in blue) can be found on page 12.
